



PROTECTING CHILDREN & SENIORS

The Children's Identification and Location Database (CHILD Project™) and Senior Safety Net™, are part of a secure, web-based, nation-wide network and registry that enables Sheriffs' Offices and social service agencies across the nation to easily enroll, locate and positively identify missing children and seniors in seconds using iris biometric recognition technology.



In 2022, the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children's call center received over 100,000 calls for reports of missing children.

The Child Project™ has been designed to help locate missing children through advanced iris biometric recognition technology, by taking a simple high-speed digital photograph of the individual's irises.

The system's enrollment and authentication soft-ware captures photo and emergency contact information for storage in The Child Project's $^{\text{\tiny M}}$ national database.





Every day, thousands of people are reported missing across the nation. There are many different types of missing persons including those who are lost, injured, or afflicted with diseases such as Alzheimer's.

Like the Child Project™, Senior Safety Net™ is a secure nationwide network and registry, developed by BI2 Technologies that enables Sheriffs' Offices and social service agencies across the nation to locate and positively identify missing persons with iris biometric recognition technology.
